

### Eligibility for membership

Every person who has received a degree or diploma conferred by the APGC, UOR/\_\_\_\_\_ shall be eligible to enroll as Alumni Member.

*Member type and eligibility for membership to the association is categorized as below:*

a) **Patron:** The Principal of Agrawal P G College, Jaipur shall be the ex-officio Patron of APGCAA.

b) **Alumni Member:** All individuals who have been conferred a degree or diploma by Agrawal P G College, Jaipur and *whose membership fees have been received by the Agrawal P G College Alumni Association*, upon graduation/postgraduation/diloma will be automatically deemed to be a member of the Alumni Association. Alumni members are expected to register with the Alumni Association for future communication and periodically update their contact information in the Alumni database, online at the APGCAA website.

c) **Associate Member:** The alumni cell and present academic staff of college shall be eligible to become Associate Member. Academic Staff who are not alumni of Agrawal P G College shall be entitled to apply for Registration of Membership in the Form prescribed by the Executive Committee of the Association.

d) **Honorary Member:** APGCAA may decide to confer honorary membership to eminent persons. All former Principals of Agrawal P G College will be honorary member. Eminent persons may be admitted to be Honorary Members, as may be considered by the Executive Committee of the Association, in consultation with the Patron. Members of SASS of APGCAA automatically become Honorary Members.

### Termination of membership

The executive committee of APGCAA may cease any individual's status as a member under any of the following circumstances:

**Death, Mental Disability, or Criminal Conviction:** If he/she dies, resigns, becomes of unsound mind, or is convicted of a criminal offence involving moral turpitude.

**Expulsion due to Misconduct per Rules:** The Executive Committee shall have power to expel a member for willful disregard to the association's rules or misconduct on the part of the member, provided that the member concerned will be given an opportunity for explaining his conduct.

*Appeal of Expulsion:* Any member thus expelled can appeal to the executive committee and to the patron for reconsideration of expulsion with justification.

**Resignation:** A resignation from membership shall be tendered to the President and it shall not take effect until it has been accepted on behalf of the Association by the executive committee.
